Thy Kingdom Come

“Save your own soul!” These words have lingered in my spirit since watching a video by Missionary Billy Cole as we prepared to enter the mission field in the nation of Spain in 2020.

This same admonition came recently to me in a new way through Sis. Vicki Vernon. She used the analogy of flying on an airplane. In the same way flight attendants instruct us that we must put on our own oxygen masks before helping our child with theirs, so too must we take care of our own personal salvation before we can minister salvation to our children and to others.

The Lord, in His gentle manner, has reminded me that my work for the kingdom does not replace my time with the King. Without regular intentional time with my Jesus, my time serving in the kingdom is futile. I need to keep my soul full of His presence by taking personal time regularly to read His word, worship Him, pray in the Holy Spirit, and to just be still in His presence. This is my “oxygen mask.”

Our children do what we do, regardless of what we say. This renewed revelation came through a hilarious conversation with my nine-year-old son while homeschooling. He said, “If I have to write another thing today, I am going to throw a level 16 fit!” Then he said, “When I am an adult, I am going to throw level 1000 fits!” I then calmly explained how when you are an adult you are mature, and you don’t throw fits. He replied with, “Oh yeah? What about you and Daddy?” He then continued to describe what in his mind were adult “fits” had by me and my husband. Our children do as we do, not necessarily as we say.

Once my oxygen mask is on, I can put on my children’s masks. The good news is

children also see the things we do right. Both my boys were filled with the gift of the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in other tongues. Within the last month a children's evangelist spoke into my oldest son's life saying, "The Lord showed me you are called to preach the Gospel!"

The fruit of me putting on my "oxygen mask" first, followed by my children's, will be the salvation of many souls for the kingdom of God. We are all called to go and preach the Gospel, bringing as many souls with us to heaven as possible so that we may rejoice in His presence and worship the One True King for all eternity! May His kingdom come in my life, my children's lives, and in the lives of the lost.
