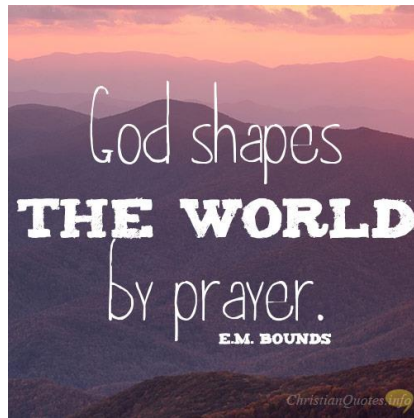
Continue to pray for complete healing for Bro. Vincent George
